

Child Protection Complaints Report 2015-2016

Background

Following the 2012 Queensland Child Protection Commission of Inquiry, the Queensland Government accepted a recommendation that each department with responsibility for child protection improve public confidence in their responsiveness to complaints by publishing a complaints report annually.

As a provider of healthcare services to children, the West Moreton Hospital and Health Service has a role in protecting the safety and wellbeing of children.
